

Student Enrollment Contract

Missouri Interactive Telecommunications Education (MIT-E) Networks

Two-way interactive television allows schools to provide low-incidence courses and dual-credit college courses to students who would not otherwise have access to them.

Because of the uniqueness of the two-way interactive television, there are certain expectations of students enrolling in these courses. This contract is intended to make both the students and parents aware of the standards expected of enrolled students.

As the undersigned student of record in a two-way interactive television course, I understand and accept the Student Enrollment Contract and agree to abide by the policies and procedures established by the Boards of Directors of the Missouri Interactive Telecommunications Education (MIT-E) Networks.

I agree that:

1. Insubordination of any kind (behaviors or incidents that disrupt or interfere with teaching or learning) will not be tolerated in the I-TV classroom;
2. Inappropriate language or gestures will not be tolerated;
3. My image and voice can be recorded at any time without advance notice;
4. I will position myself in the classroom to be in camera view at all times;
5. I will not manipulate equipment in the classroom without the expressed direction or permission from supervisors or instructors;
6. I will not be involved in any academically dishonest activity; I will not cheat nor assist others in cheating;
7. I will conform to any additional rules specified by the instructor.

Further, I understand that if I am found to be in violation of any of the policies listed above, I will be subject to the following disciplinary action:

First Offense Verbal or written warning from instructor followed by parental notification of the infraction through written letter. The warning will be delivered to the student using procedures that assure student privacy. A copy of the letter will also be sent to the student's principal.

Second Offense The student will be removed from the class until such time that a conference of parents, student, instructor, and principal offers assurance that the misconduct will not reoccur.

Severe Misconduct Including damage or defacing I-TV equipment or facilities; threats; violent behavior or intent; drug or alcohol use; or repeated policy violation may result in permanent removal from the class. The student may be subject to loss of full or partial credit for coursework.

This Student Contract does not supercede policies for student conduct recognized by the student's home school.
